

OPIOID ANTAGONIST MEDICATION FUND REPORT

Section 135.190A(6) requires the Department to submit a report annually detailing a list of deposits and expenditures from the Opioid Antagonist Medicaid Fund for the prior fiscal year and the amount of carryover funds. This is a new code section for state fiscal year SFY23.

The purpose of the fund is to provide appropriations to the Department for the purchase, maintenance, and replacement of opioid antagonist medication administered by first responders to persons experiencing an opioid-related overdose.

As of December 12, 2022, there have been no deposits in the fund.
