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Postsecondary Attainment Institute – FY23

Iowa Code Section 261.8, subsection 10, requires that the corporation for educational financial assistance, services, and research (the Postsecondary Attainment Institute) submit an annual report on the activities and operations of the entity.

The corporation shall submit by January 15 annually a written report of its activities and operations to the governor, the general assembly, and the commission.

Iowa College Aid received authority to develop a non-profit corporation during the 2021 legislative session. During the 2023 fiscal year, the Iowa College Student Aid Commission (Commission) received the necessary approvals from the Iowa Secretary of State and the U.S. Internal Revenue Service to formally create the non-profit corporation. The corporation is known as the Postsecondary Attainment Institute. To date, the Institute has received \$2,500 in donations, for assistance in the development and start-up of the non-profit.

During the 2023 fiscal year, the Postsecondary Attainment Institute achieved the following:

- Board meetings were held in July 2022 and March 2023.
- A logo was developed and a mission statement was created, “The Postsecondary Attainment Institute increases family and community success through advocacy and support for postsecondary completion.”
- An email address and website address were established.
