## INTRODUCTION

Legislation on submission of federal special education reports to the state legislature was passed in 2010. The relevant section is quoted below.

Sec. 2. Section 256B.3, Code 2009, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 14A. To submit copies of all reports the division provides to the United States department of education under part B of the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, as amended, including but not limited to any report concerning disproportionate representation in special education based on race or ethnicity, to the general assembly on the date each such report is provided to the United States department of education.
