HSEM administers the state's emergency notification system, Alert Iowa. Launched in 2014, the system is available for emergency messaging for all counties and provides those that choose to participate with access to a single statewide notification system that gives local control of how and when to disseminate emergency and public safety information to residents. At the close of SFY 2024, 92 counties were using the system to provide emergency notifications to residents. The system has continuously been used to send emergency communications and weather notifications across the state to residents. The system is also available to all State Agencies for internal emergency and coop/cog messaging needs.
