

Provider Portal queries represent clinical team, provider or other care management professionals seeking the health information to make care decisions. By securely sharing data, longitudinal health records reduce duplicate tests, improve care coordination and help clinicians make timely and informed decisions. Patient health information is protected, used only to support care, and is never shared without purpose. When information flows responsibly, care becomes more connected.

Advancements in Quality Reporting & Compliance Support

In 2025, we achieved CMS Qualified Registry status. This enables Iowa clinicians to streamline their quality reporting for CMS programs through 2026. As a qualified registry, we can collect clinical data, calculate quality measures, and submit performance information directly to CMS on behalf of providers.

Additionally, we expanded our service to payers by introducing historical member data request capabilities for CMS auditing. Today, Iowa payers can more efficiently respond to CMS audit requirements by accessing longitudinal member information.

Health Information in Iowa

Across 125 facilities in Iowa, more than 340 million standardized health messages were securely exchanged through the Provider Portal.

Conditions of Participation (CoP) Provider Notifications

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has issued revisions to its CoP. Designed to improve interoperability between care providers across the medical community and comply with this requirement, hospitals are notifying providers via the Provider Portal when their patients have an emergency room or inpatient encounter at an acute care or critical access facility.



CoP Notifications Received by Providers




