

HHS Judicial Review Report for FY26

REPORT REQUIREMENT

Legislatively required report for the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services per Iowa Code 625.29.

Iowa Code 625.29(7) states, each agency that pays fees or other expenses for an action for judicial review of an agency proceeding under chapter 17A shall report annually to the chairs and ranking members of the appropriate appropriations subcommittees of the general assembly the amount of fees or other expenses paid during the preceding fiscal year by that agency. In its report the agency shall describe the number, nature, and amount of the awards, the claims involved in the action, and other relevant information which might aid the general assembly in evaluating the scope and impact of these awards.

REPORT DETAILS

Iowa HHS was ordered to pay \$150 for an appellate filing fee in *Tagge v. Iowa Department of Health and Human Services*. See *Tagge*, No. 24-1430 (Iowa Ct. App. April 1, 2026). The case involved a dispute between the parties related to transmission of the agency record to the district court.
