Re: Section 8.62 Report of Moneys Expended

This report is submitted in accordance with Section 8.62, Code of Iowa. This is the report relating to expenditures of FY 2025 Training and Technology (T&T) dollars carried forward for expenditure during FY 2026. Section 8.62 requires that copies of the report be distributed to the Administration and Regulation Appropriations Subcommittee, the Legislative Services Agency, and the Fiscal Committee of the Legislative Council. A copy is to be submitted to the Department of Management.

The Department's divisions (Administration, Administrative Hearings, Health Facilities, Investigations, and Professional Licensing) were able to retain a total of \$313,163.75 with the carry forward of fifty percent of eligible reversion funds. The divisions spent a total of \$313,163.75 for equipment replacement, and general technology upgrades.

Those Department's attached units are as follows:

- The Iowa Civil Rights Commission was able to get \$2,178.64 and spent \$2,178.64 for technology equipment replacement and general technology.
- The Employment Appeal Board was able to carry forward \$367,234.89, and spent \$64,011.39 for technology equipment replacement and general technology. Remaining amount of \$303,223.50 will get reverted back to the general fund.
- The Racing and Gaming Commission does not have carry-forward authority.
- The State Public Defenders' Office is submitting a separate report.
