Gentlemen:

Pursuant to section 1(2) of House File 2558 (2006), the Iowa Department of Justice (Department) submits the following report of the Department's actual costs and an estimate of the time expended enforcing the Iowa competition law. For fiscal year 2006, the Department expended \$176,125 to enforce the competition law. The Department estimates approximately 1.35 FTEs (2,808 hours) were incurred in these enforcement efforts.

Pursuant to section 1(3) of House File 2558 (2006), the Department submits the following report of the Department's actual costs and an estimate of the time incurred in providing public education pursuant to and enforcing such section. For fiscal year 2006, the Department expended \$599,138 for these activities. The Department estimates approximately 6.48 FTEs (13,478) were incurred carrying out these activities.
