Dear Governor Culver:

This report is filed as required by Chapter 1119, Section 9 of the Laws of the Eighty- First
General Assembly.

The following table lists the cases enforced by child support that did not pay support for a period
of one year or more and or owe \$5000 or more.

There is some duplication in the two sets of data. We were unable to determine if all of the
individuals met the criteria of having the ability to pay. The reported data does include
6053 individuals that live in another state and 2459 individuals for whom there are not a known
address. The reported data does not include 2,757 individuals who were in prison, or 840
individuals who were receiving SSI disability payments, or 586 individuals who were receiving
Family Investment Payments.

There are 159,735 cases with a court order enforced by the state of Iowa.

Table with 2 columns: Category and Cases. Row 1: No child support payment in 12 months, 23,071 cases. Row 2: Delinquency greater than \$5,000, 8,712 cases.

For the cases that DHS enforces, there has not been criminal prosecution pursuant to Chapter
726.5.
