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# Class Size 2012-2013

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## Introduction

Class size reduction for the early elementary grades remained a state goal in 2012-2013, continuing efforts initiated by the Iowa Early Intervention Block Grant Program (House File 743) in 1999. Iowa's class size reduction goals established in Iowa Code Chapter 256D are 17 students per one teacher for basic skills instruction, provide direction and resources to help districts achieve a high level of student success in basic skills, especially reading skills; and increase communication and accountability regarding student performance.

Table 1 provides a breakdown of funding from FY2000 through FY2013.

## Methodology

Public school districts report the number of kindergarten, first, second, and third grade classroom sections, students, teachers, and aides by building during the Fall Basic Educational Data Survey (BEDS). Special education teachers and aides are not included in the reporting. Physical education, art, music, and other "specialty" and "pull-out" program (such as Title I reading and math) teachers are also excluded from the teacher count.

Some districts utilize multi-age classrooms for their K-3 students. For example, a classroom may combine first and second grade students in one room. Districts may report these combination

classrooms as grade level “Other” on the Class Size submission, but these classrooms are not included in this report. The Department of Education calculated average class size for kindergarten through third grade at the district and state level. Average class size equals the number of students divided by the number of classrooms for each grade level.

$$\text{Average Class Size} = \text{Number of Students} / \text{Number of Classrooms}$$

Since average class size uses the number of classrooms as the denominator, adding additional teachers to a classroom does not lower the average class size for that grade level (refer to Appendix B for the full-time equivalent [FTE] of classroom teachers). The use of classroom aides also does not reduce average class size at the district or state level.

## Findings

This report provides class size data from 1998-1999 to 2012-2013 for kindergarten through third grade. Average class size increased in 2012-2013 for kindergarten only. First and second grade remained steady while third grade decreased slightly, when compared to 2011-2012 (see Table 2 and Figure 1). Kindergarten through second grade average was at the highest level since 1998-1999. This is the third consecutive year all grades showed average class size of 20 or above. Third grade continued to show the highest average class size per classroom of the grades examined, at 21.4 students per classroom for 2012-2013, and remained above 20 students in each year studied.

The average class size in 2012-2013 stayed about the same as the prior year. Examining long term trends shows a steady increase in class size over time. In 2012-13, the kindergarten grade level saw an increase for the third year in a row. Kindergarten through second grades continues to be at or above class size levels from the 1998-1999 school year. Since the inception of the Class Size reduction funding, third grade class sizes continues to be slightly below 1998-1999 levels.

Average class sizes have declined for kindergarten through second grade from 1998-1999 through 2001-2002, but increased in each of the subsequent years through 2005-2006. In 2006-2007, kindergarten average class sizes declined slightly, but have continued to climb since. Third grade showed a decline from 1998-1999 through 2002-2003, but experienced alternating increases and decreases through 2005-2006. Starting in 2006-2007, third grade showed either steady or increasing class sizes through 2012-2013.

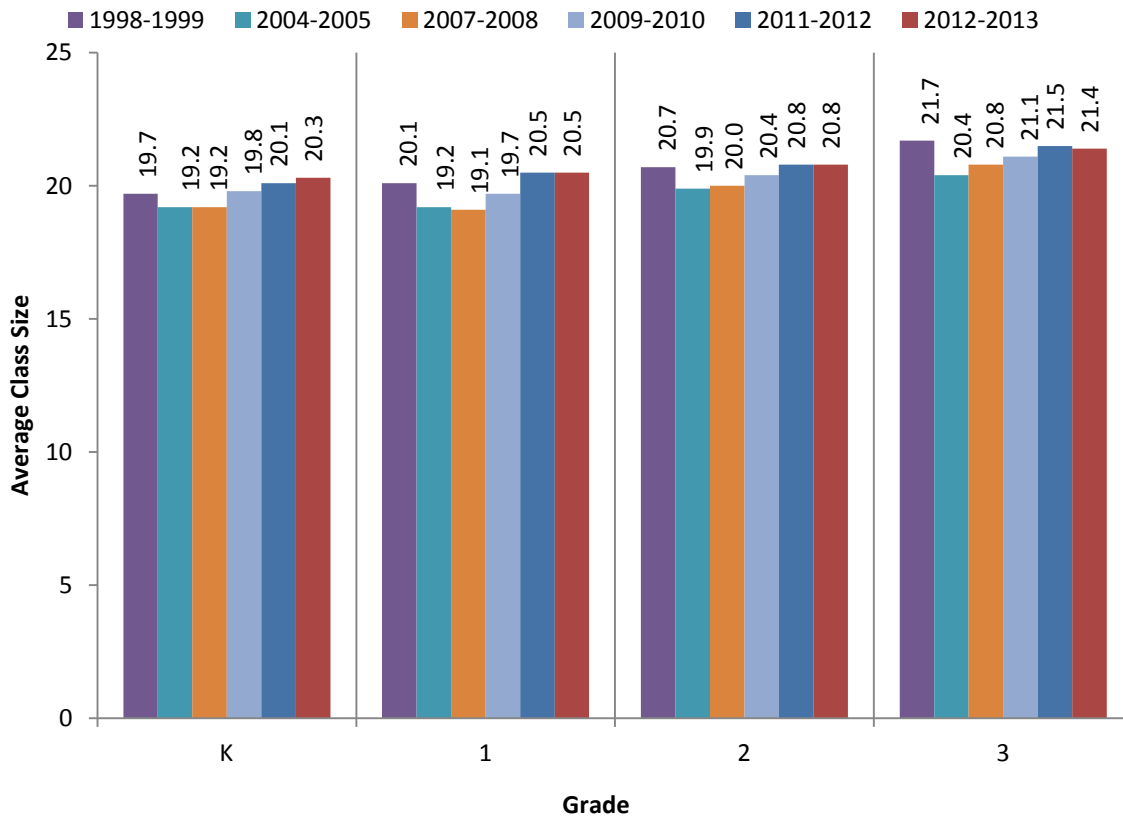

The smallest districts were more likely to meet the state goal of 17.0 students per classroom in 2012-2013. The average class size for all grades was below 17.0 students per classroom for the <300 enrollment category since inception of the program. The larger districts were more likely to show the highest average class sizes in 2012-2013. The 2,500-7,499 and 7,500+ enrollment categories experienced average class sizes of 21 or more for all grades for the past four years. The average class size for these enrollment categories remained above 20 students per classroom for the past eleven years. Since the inception of the Class Size reduction funding, districts with 600 students or greater have been unable to reach the goal of 17 students per classroom for all grades.

The average class size for the smallest ten districts in the state was less than 12 students per classroom for all grades. The average class size for the largest ten districts in the state was above 21.6 students per classroom for all grades.

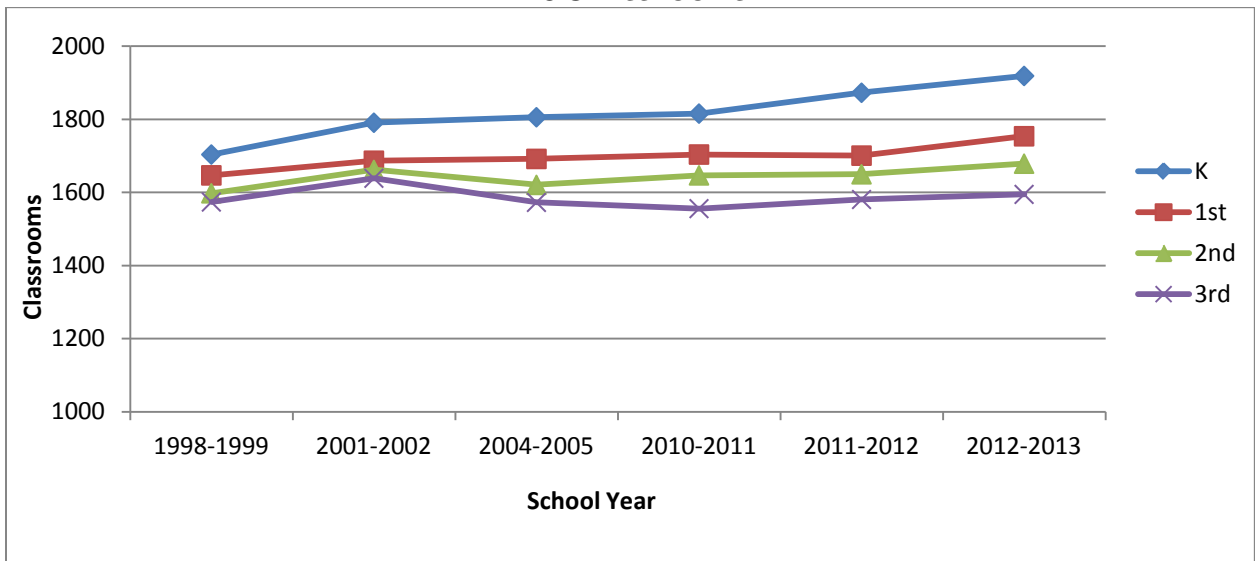

The percentage of classrooms above the state goal of 17 students per classroom increased in 2012-2013 for kindergarten and third grade from the previous year. The greatest increase was in kindergarten classrooms where the percent of classrooms above 17 students went from 79.3 percent in 2011-2012 to 80.3 percent in 2012-2013. First and second grade showed a slight decrease from 2011-2012.

This is the third year the growth in the number of teachers has not outpaced the growth in the number of students for first grade from 1998-1999 to 2012-2013 (see Figures 3 and 4). The number of first grade students increased 8.8 percent since 1998-1999, but the number of first grade teachers increased only 6.7 percent during the same period. The number of students outpaced the growth in the number of classrooms for kindergarten through second grade (see Figures 2 and 3). Kindergarten showed an increase in students of 15.9 percent, while the increase in the number of classrooms was 12.6 percent since 1998-1999.

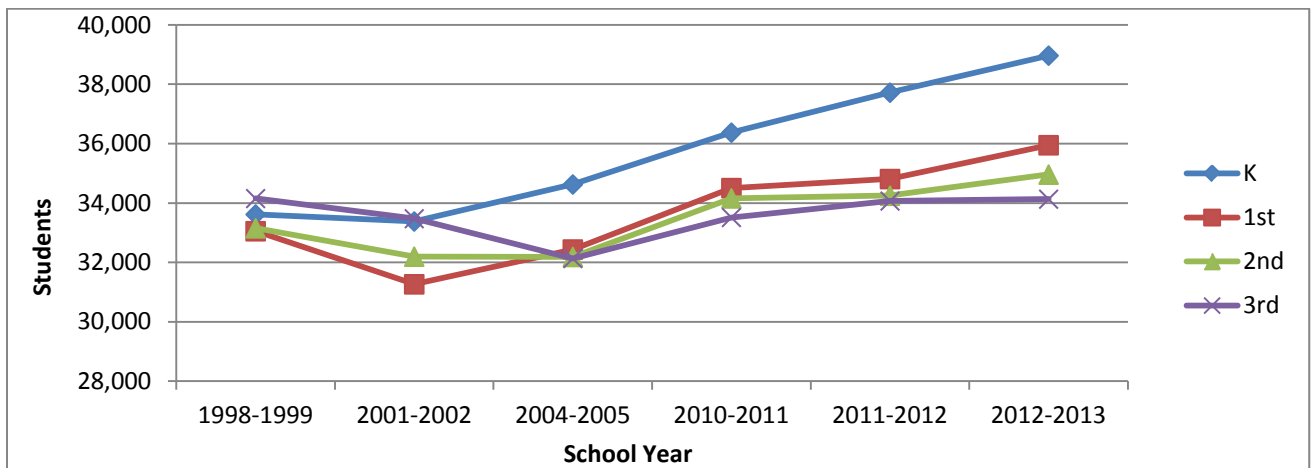
**NUMBER OF IOWA PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS

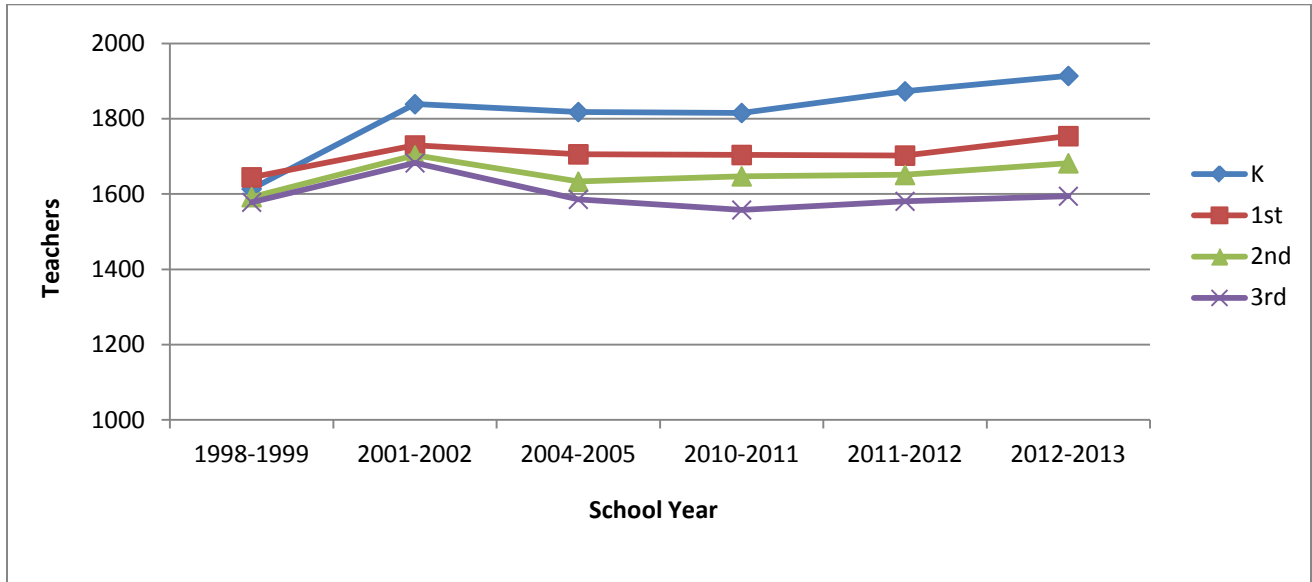
**NUMBER OF IOWA PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Changes in enrollment from 1998-1999 to 2012-2013 outpaced the changes in average class size during the same period for kindergarten, second, and third grade (see Tables 9 and 10). During this period, average class size declined 1.4 percent for third grade while enrollment decreased 2.8 percent. Kindergarten class size increased by only 3.0 percent while the enrollment increased by 15.7 percent when compared to 1998-1999.

## Expenditures

District expenditures increased in FY 2012 to \$30,511,571 with salaries consuming the largest percentage of the total. Purchased Services, Supplies and Other categories was below 1.0 percent each (see Table 11 and Figure 5).

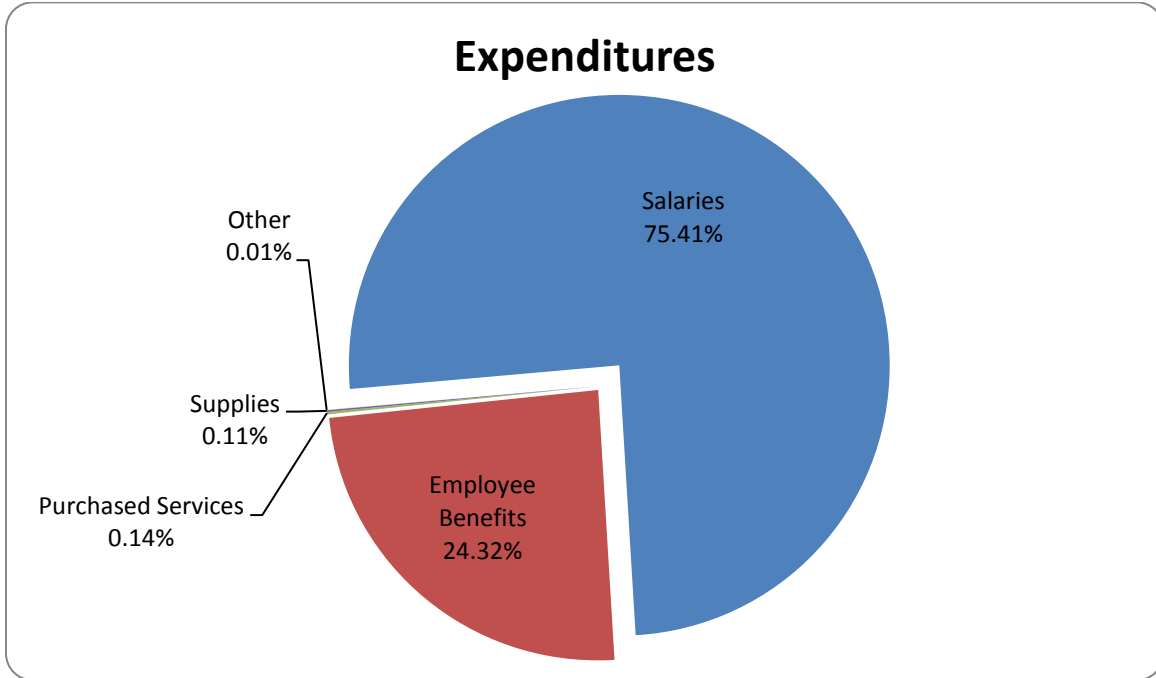

In FY 2012, the largest districts (+7,500) spent the smallest percentage of early intervention funds on staff salaries at 72.7 percent. Small districts in the <300 and 300-599 enrollment categories spent the highest percentage of funds on staff salaries, above 77 percent, yet paid fewer benefits than the larger districts. The very smallest districts utilized purchased services, and supplies the most in FY 2012 at around 3 percent. Overall, the percentage difference of categorical expenditures did not vary significantly among the enrollment categories.
