Re: Section 8.62 Report of Moneys Expended – Final Report

This report is submitted in accordance with Section 8.62, Code of Iowa. This is the final report relating to expenditures of FY14 Training and Technology (T&T) dollars carried forward for expenditure during FY15. Section 8.62 requires that copies of the final report be distributed to the Administration and Regulation Appropriations Subcommittee, the Legislative Services Agency, and the Fiscal Committee of the Legislative Council. A copy is to be submitted to the Department of Management.

The Department's divisions (Administration, Food & Consumer Safety, Administrative Hearings, Investigations, and Health Facilities) were able to retain a total of \$312,330 with the carry forward of fifty percent of eligible reversion funds. The divisions spent a total of \$166,303 for general technology upgrades and equipment replacement.

These funds were available for reversion and carry forward due primarily to the delay in reimbursements from the federal government and other state agencies for services provided by our Department during the last quarter of the fiscal year, temporarily vacant positions, and other economies achieved during the year.

Those Department's attached units are as follows:

- The Child Advocacy Board was able to carry forward \$29,855, and spent 100% of that amount for general technology upgrades and equipment replacement.
- The Employment Appeal Board was able to carry forward \$2,116, and spent \$1,917 for general technology upgrades and equipment replacement.
- The Racing and Gaming Commission does not have carry-forward authority.
- The State Public Defenders' Office is submitting a separate report.
