RE: Public Employment Relations Board report on the use of reversions  
pursuant to Iowa Code  
Section 8.62

In Fiscal Year 2015, the Public Employment Relations Board carried over unspent funds. The portion of reversion funds available for reuse in the following fiscal year 2016 was \$71,269.00. The agency spent \$29,803.44 of that reversion and will leave \$41,465.56 of that amount unspent. The reversion funds that were used were spent in the following manner:

\$5,800.00 to Tybera, which provides technology support for our eFiling system and included a system upgrade to add another service, annual filing, which will be added as an online function of the agency.

\$9,710.94 to HP for the purchase of new computers for the Board and staff, replacing the previous computers that were utilized by the agency.

\$869.50 to Iowa Prison Industries for a credenza for an office of an Administrative Law Judge, arm chair pads for current Board member and plaque for retiring Board member.

\$3593.00 to Iowa Prison Industries for two chairs, a power up computer stand, two bookcases and a credenza for a new Administrative Law Judge. That position had been unfilled and her office did not have a full array of furnishings.

\$4098.00 to Iowa Prison Industries for office furniture of new Board member, including a new credenza, corner power up computer stand, bookcase, four chairs, and one desk chair for her office, replacing current furniture, except for the power up stand.

\$720.00 for eDas training on Acrobat level 1 and 2 for staff member.

\$3,012.00 for digital recorders from Wahltek that are used in recording hearings and meetings conducted by the agency.

\$1,496.00 to eDas for computer installation costs.

\$504.00 to PDS-New Horizons for SQL computer training course for two Administrative Law Judges and one Board member.
