Introduction

Iowa Code 29C.20B(4) requires the Iowa Department of Humans Services (DHS) to report annually by January 1 of each year, to the Legislative Fiscal Committee and the Government Oversight Committee concerning the activities of the Iowa Individual Assistance Grant Program (IIAGP) for the previous fiscal year.

State Fiscal Year 2017

Beginning in July 2016, Iowa began to experience severe storm systems which created straight-line winds, heavy rains, large hail, and flooding resulting in significant damage to private/personal property across some Iowa counties. Governor Branstad proclaimed the following disaster emergencies.
