**RE: Report on Board of Medicine's use of Iowa Code Sections 272C.4 (11) and 272C.4 (12)**

Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 272C.4(13), the Iowa Board of Medicine provides the following report to the Governor of Iowa and the General Assembly of Iowa concerning the Board's use of the provisions of Iowa Code sections 272C.4(11) and 272C.4(12) since December 15, 2016, for applicants for a license to practice acupuncture or to practice medicine in Iowa.

**272C.4(11) - Credits received by individuals for education, training and service: 0 (No applicants for medical or acupuncture licenses requested this credit in the period covered by this report.)**

**272C.4(12) - Expedited licensing of an individual who is licensed in a similar profession or occupation in another state and who indicated veteran: 91 medical license applicants. (No veteran sought an acupuncture license in the period covered by this report.)**
