Rule Summary

Removes obsolete, outdated, inconsistent, and incompatible rules pursuant to 2023 lowa Acts, Senate File 562 (FY 2024 Justice System Appropriations Act). Increases the hourly rate for payment of claims from the Indigent Defense Fund for attorney and guardian ad litem fees and allows payments for associated travel time in situations where payment had not been allowed prior to the legislative change.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code section <u>815.7(6),(7),(7A)</u>, and 2023 Iowa Acts, Senate File 562 (FY 2024 Justice System Appropriations Act).

Fiscal Impact

Agency Response: The estimated annual cost of the increase in the hourly rate of the fees for attorneys and guardians ad litem will be approximately \$2.6 million. The estimated annual cost of the increase in travel time allowed will be approximately \$1.5 million.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs.

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
