ADMINISTRATIVE RULES — FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARIES

lowa Code section <u>17A.4(4)</u> requires the Legislative Services Agency (LSA) to analyze the fiscal impact of all administrative rules with an impact of \$100,000 or more and provide a summary of the impact to the Administrative Rules Review Committee (ARRC). With each rule summary, the rulemaking type is indicated in parentheses following the ARC number. The acronyms have the following meanings: Notice of Intended Action (**NOIA**), Amended Notice of Intended Action (**ANOIA**), Notice of Termination (**NOT**), Adopted and Filed Emergency (**AFE**), Filed Emergency After Notice (**FEAN**), and Adopted and Filed (**AF**).

ARC 7719C (AF)

Rule Summary Creates a new renewal option for a license, certificate, statement of professional recognition, and authorization with a reduced fee.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code sections <u>272.2</u> and <u>272.10</u>; 2023 Iowa Acts, House File <u>672</u> (Permanent Teaching Licensure Act); and 2023 Iowa Acts, House File <u>688</u> (Administrative Rules Clean Up Act).

Fiscal Impact Agency Response: No new costs are anticipated; however, agency revenues will be reduced by an estimated \$116,000 per year. Twenty-five percent of fees collected annually by the Educational Examiners Board are credited to the General Fund, and the reduction in fees will result in a decrease of approximately \$37,000 to the General Fund annually.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs.

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
