ADMINISTRATIVE RULES — FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARIES

Iowa Code section 17A.4(4) requires the Legislative Services Agency (LSA) to analyze the fiscal impact of all administrative rules with an impact of \$100,000 or more and provide a summary of the impact to the Administrative Rules Review Committee (ARRC). With each rule summary, the rulemaking type is indicated in parentheses following the ARC number. The acronyms have the following meanings: Notice of Intended Action (**NOIA**), Amended Notice of Intended Action (**ANOIA**), Notice of Termination (**NOT**), Adopted and Filed Emergency (**AFE**), Filed Emergency After Notice (**FEAN**), and Adopted and Filed (**AF**).

Department of Health and Human Services

ARC 8042C (AF)

Rule Summary Sets forth the Department of Health and Human Services' procedure in administering the Grants to Counties Program for the purpose of testing private water wells, reconstructing private water wells, and the proper plugging of abandoned private water wells within the jurisdiction of each county board of health.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code sections 135.11 and 455E.11.

Fiscal Impact **Agency Response:** No fiscal impact.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs in part. Due to the increased flexibility in the administration of the Program, any potential fiscal impact is unknown.

ARC 7935C (NOIA)

Rule Summary Creates rules for the licensure and regulation of certified professional midwives. Sets out requirements for certified professional midwives to obtain a license in the State of Iowa, including initial licensure, renewal, and reactivation.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code chapter 148I and 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 265 (Midwives, Licensure Act).

Fiscal Impact **Agency Response:** No fiscal impact.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs in part. The **Fiscal Note** for HF 265 estimated that the initial start-up costs of establishing a new licensing board would require an estimated \$149,000 in the first fiscal year. Of this amount, \$94,000 is attributable to database modification costs, \$25,000 is for administrative and staffing costs, and \$30,000 is for support costs paid to the Attorney General's Office. The Fiscal Note estimated ongoing costs to be \$43,000 annually.
