ADMINISTRATIVE RULES — FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARIES

December 10, 2024

Iowa Code section 17A.4(4) requires the Legislative Services Agency (LSA) to analyze the fiscal impact of all administrative rules with an impact of \$100,000 or more and provide a summary of the impact to the Administrative Rules Review Committee (ARRC). With each rule summary, the rulemaking type is indicated in parentheses following the ARC number. The acronyms have the following meanings: Notice of Intended Action (**NOIA**), Amended Notice of Intended Action (**ANOIA**), Notice of Termination (**NOT**), Adopted and Filed Emergency (**AFE**), Filed Emergency After Notice (**FEAN**), and Adopted and Filed (**AF**).

Department of Transportation

ARC 8396C (NOIA)

Rule Summary Outlines the procedures to be followed when a police authority or private entity acting on behalf of a police authority disposes of an abandoned vehicle and seeks reimbursement from or seeks to remit unclaimed proceeds to the Department of Transportation.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code sections 321.1, 321.18, 321.71, 321.89, and 321.90.

Fiscal Impact **Agency Response:** This rulemaking has a positive fiscal impact to the State of Iowa of approximately \$115,000 annually, which represents the net amount of excess funds received from abandoned vehicle disposals, which is deposited into the Road Use Tax Fund.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs in part. The \$115,000 is the approximate annual revenue from abandoned vehicles in previous fiscal years and is no net increase in revenue to the Road Use Tax Fund due to this rulemaking.

Department of Health and Human Services

ARC 8415C (AF)

Rule Summary Implements a subsidized adoption program for children with special needs, older children, and children otherwise hard to place in an adoptive home. Sets forth eligibility requirements, program procedures, and subsidy amounts for adoption subsidies.

State or Federal Law Implemented: 2024 Iowa Acts, House File 2698 (FY 2025 Health and Human Services Appropriations Act), and Iowa Code sections 600.17, 600.18, 600.19, 600.20, 600.21, 600.22, and 600.23.

Fiscal Impact **Agency Response:** No fiscal impact.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs. This rulemaking has no fiscal impact to the State beyond that of the legislation it is intended to implement. House File 2698 allocated approximately \$148,000 from the General Fund to increase the adoption subsidy by 5.0% over the rates in effect on June 30, 2024.

Rule Summary Updates procedures related to the Crime Victim Assistance Program to improve overall services for victims.

State or Federal Law Implemented: Iowa Code chapters 709 and 915.

Fiscal Impact **Agency Response:** A fiscal impact of approximately \$125,000 each year is expected due to increased reimbursement of mileage for qualified providers.

LSA Response: The LSA concurs.
