### ADMINISTRATIVE RULES — FISCAL IMPACT SUMMARIES

May 11, 2026

Iowa Code section 17A.4(4) requires the Legislative Services Agency (LSA) to analyze the fiscal impact of all administrative rules with an impact of \$100,000 or more and provide a summary of the impact to the Administrative Rules Review Committee (ARRC). #### Department of Inspections, Appeals, and Licensing

#### **ARC 0247D (AF)**

**Rule Summary** Permits dental assistants to practice in Iowa without a requirement to be registered if they complete a term of practical training.

**State or Federal Law Implemented:** Iowa Code chapter 153 and 2025 Iowa Acts, House File 805 (Dental Assistant Licensing Act).

**Fiscal Impact** **Agency Response:** No fiscal impact.

**LSA Response:** The LSA concurs in part. This rulemaking has no fiscal impact beyond that of the legislation it is intended to implement. By removing the registration requirement for dental assistants, HF 805 is estimated to decrease application processing costs by approximately \$71,000 annually and decrease the application registration and renewal fee revenues to the Licensing and Regulation Fund by approximately \$354,000 in even-numbered fiscal years and by approximately \$20,000 in odd-numbered fiscal years.
