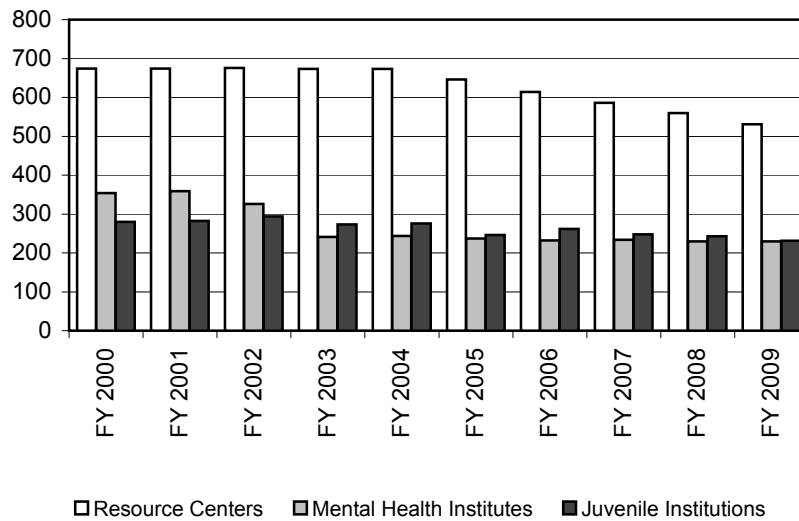


AVERAGE DAILY CENSUS (IOWA HUMAN SERVICES INSTITUTIONS)



- Between FY 2000 and FY 2009, the average daily census at the two State Resource Centers decreased 21.2% due to increased use of community-based residential programs and services.
- Between FY 2000 and FY 2009, the average daily census at the four mental health institutes decreased 35.0% due to bed closures.
- Between FY 2000 and FY 2009, the average daily census at the two juvenile institutions decreased 17.5% due to changes in statutory admission guidelines and bed closures.
