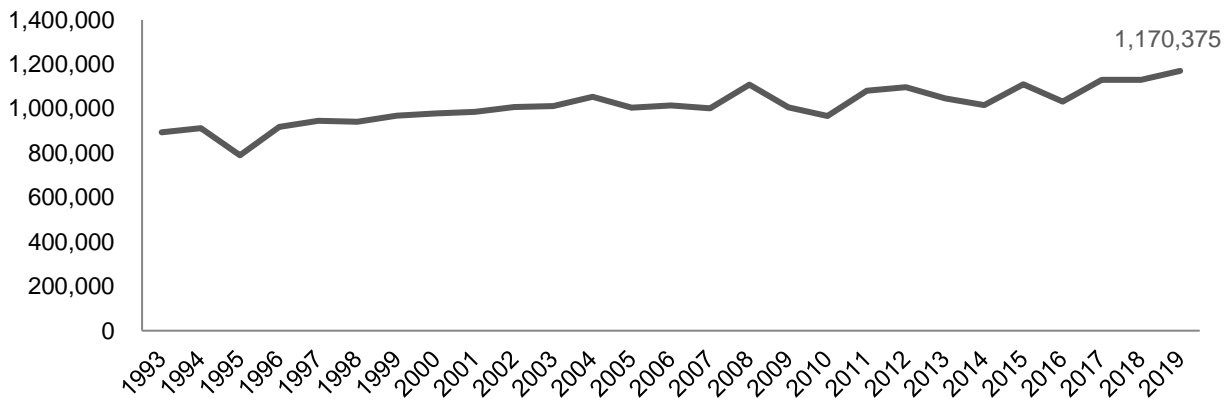

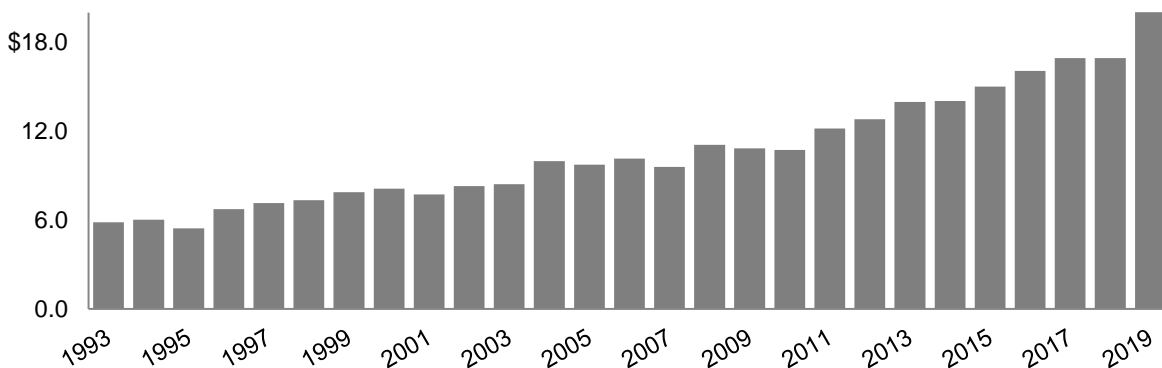

### Notes:

- 1) State Fair fiscal years run November 1 to October 31. State capitals appropriations are reflected in the prior fiscal year. For example, in State FY 2019, the State appropriated \$8.5 million for capitals. This is reflected in the State Fair's fiscal year 2018.
- 2) Other revenue includes campground fees, attractions, commercial exhibitors, sales of promotional items, and miscellaneous sources. Beginning in FY 2019, some revenues listed as other in previous years are included in the Concessions line-item.
- 4) Vendor sales are as reported by vendors and include food, beer, and merchandise. The State Fair receives a varying percentage of vendor proceeds.
