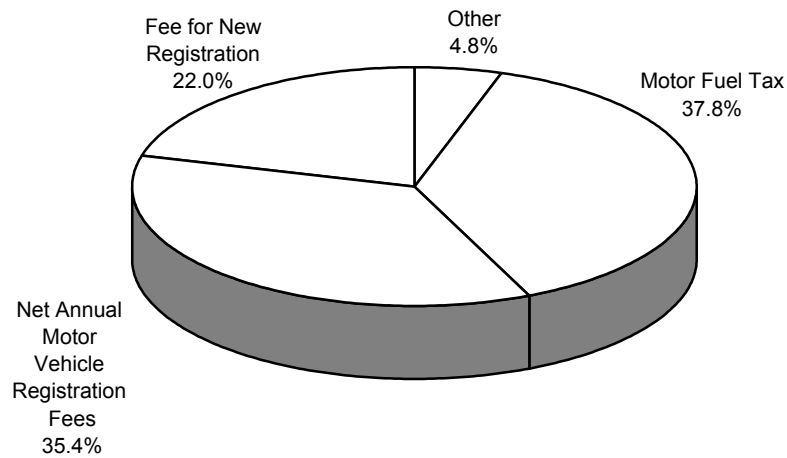


FY 2009 IOWA ROAD USE TAX FUND REVENUE



- Road Use Tax Fund revenues totaled approximately \$1.118 billion in FY 2009. During the 2008 Legislative Session, legislation was enacted that significantly changed the funding structure of the Road Use Tax Fund. As a result, revenues from previous years cannot be directly compared to FY 2009.
- Fuel tax rates are subject to change depending on the percentage of ethanol-blended gasoline sold during the previous calendar year. The tax rate on ethanol-blended gasoline ranges from 19.0 cents to 20.0 cents per gallon, while the rate on unblended gasoline ranges from 20.0 cents to 21.0 cents per gallon. Fuel tax receipts have grown 20.0% less than the rate of inflation over the past nine years.
