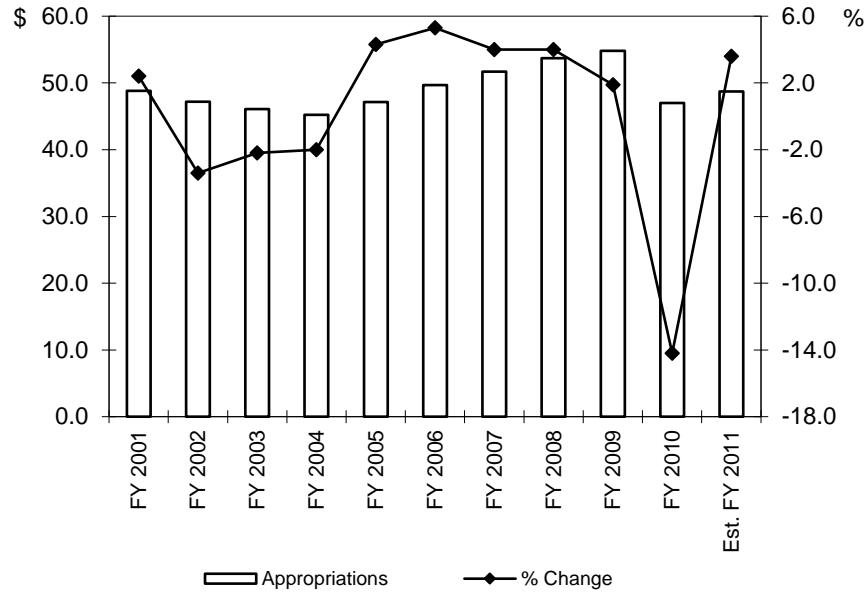


## GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FOR TUITION GRANTS FY 2001- FY 2011
