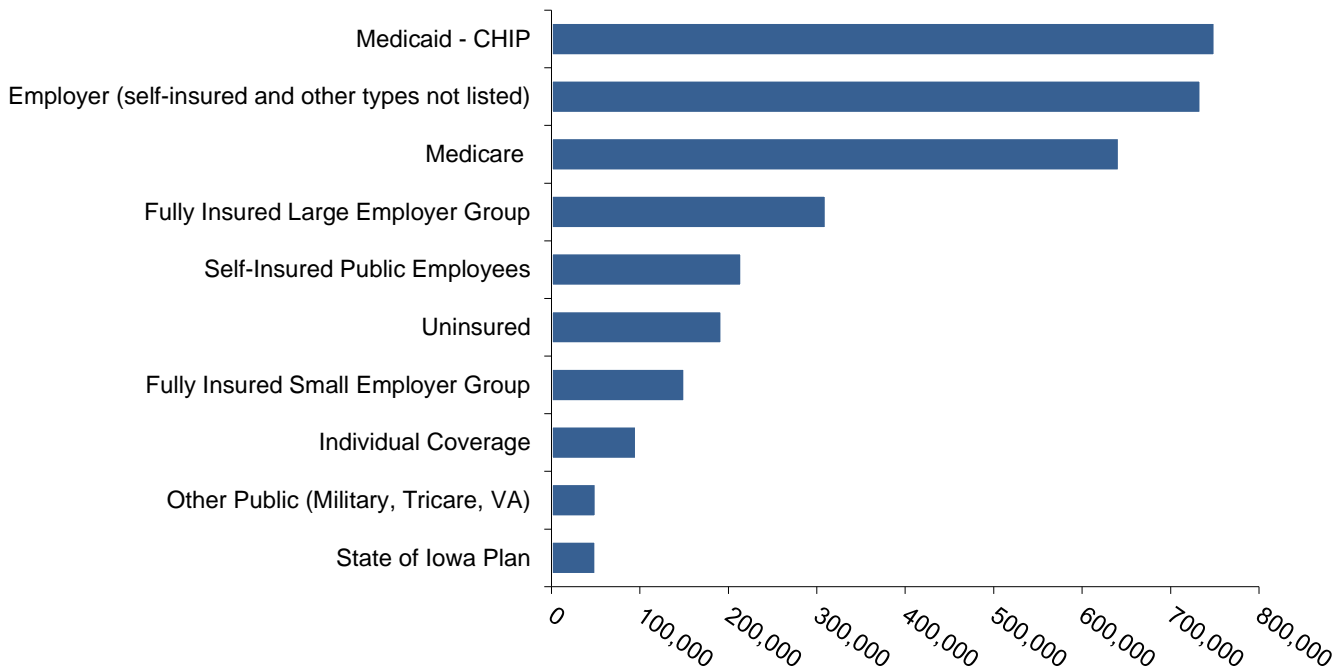


Iowa Insurance Coverage by Category — 2021

Insurance Plans Impacted by State Mandates

The table below details the types of coverage that are generally impacted by proposed and enacted insurance mandates in the Iowa Code. Approximately 25.5% of the population (814,000) are impacted by mandates. This includes individual coverage, fully insured small and large employer groups, self-insured public employees, and the State of Iowa plan.

Of the individuals not covered by the mandate, approximately 46.7% are covered by government-sponsored health insurance, 21.1% are covered by employer coverage that is governed by the federal Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), and the remaining 6.7% are uninsured.
