Notes:

- 1) New cases with existing debt is a key factor in the total amount of debt owed. In FY 2023, the Child Support Recovery Unit opened 1,354 cases with existing debt of \$7,858,076.
- 2) Approximately 27.0% of the debt owed to the State of Iowa is owed on cases where a parent lives in another state. There are 20,115 cases where the parent lives in another state.
- 3) A portion of the debt owed to Iowa (approximately two-thirds), when paid, will be returned to the federal government to offset federal costs of supporting these families.
- 4) This data represents total debt owed on Title IV-D Child Support Recovery Unit cases only. The number of Title IV-D cases in Iowa was 139,547 as of June 30, 2023.
