

Note: Refugees, according to the U.S. Department of State, are persons of special humanitarian concern who can establish that they have experienced persecution or a well-founded fear of persecution related to race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.

Of the total 1,515 refugees who arrived in Iowa in federal fiscal year (FFY) 2023, the country of origin totals are as follows: Afghanistan with 60 refugees, Burma with 107, Burundi with 45, Central African Republic with 13, Colombia with 28, Cuba with 2, Democratic Republic of Congo with 857, El Salvador with 4, Eritrea with 46, Ethiopia with 19, Guatemala with 17, Honduras with 9, Iraq with 10, Ivory Coast with 2, Nicaragua with 8, Republic of South Sudan with 34, Rwanda with 1, Somalia with 44, Sudan with 37, Syria with 154, and Venezuela with 18.
