

## City Consolidated Property Tax Rates — FY 2024

## Highest 10 Consolidated Tax Rates:



Note: Only cities with a population over 10,000 are shown on the map. The highest 10 consolidated tax rates includes all cities, regardless of population. The consolidated property tax rate is the aggregate of property tax levied within the city, divided by the total taxable valuation (with gas, electric, and water utilities) within the city, with the result multiplied by \$1,000. Agricultural property and property that is exempt from the city rate is not included in the average consolidated rate calculation.
