


# Selected Iowa Population Facts — 2023

In 2023, Iowa had **940** incorporated places.


- There were 666 places with fewer than 1,000 residents.
- There were 108 places with between 1,000 and 1,999 residents.
- There were 80 places with between 2,000 and 4,999 residents.
- There were 44 places with between 5,000 and 9,999 residents.
- There were 31 places with between 10,000 and 49,999 residents.
- There were 11 places with more than 50,000 residents.

## Percentage of Population Change in Select Cities from 2020 to 2023:


- -7.8% to -3.0%


