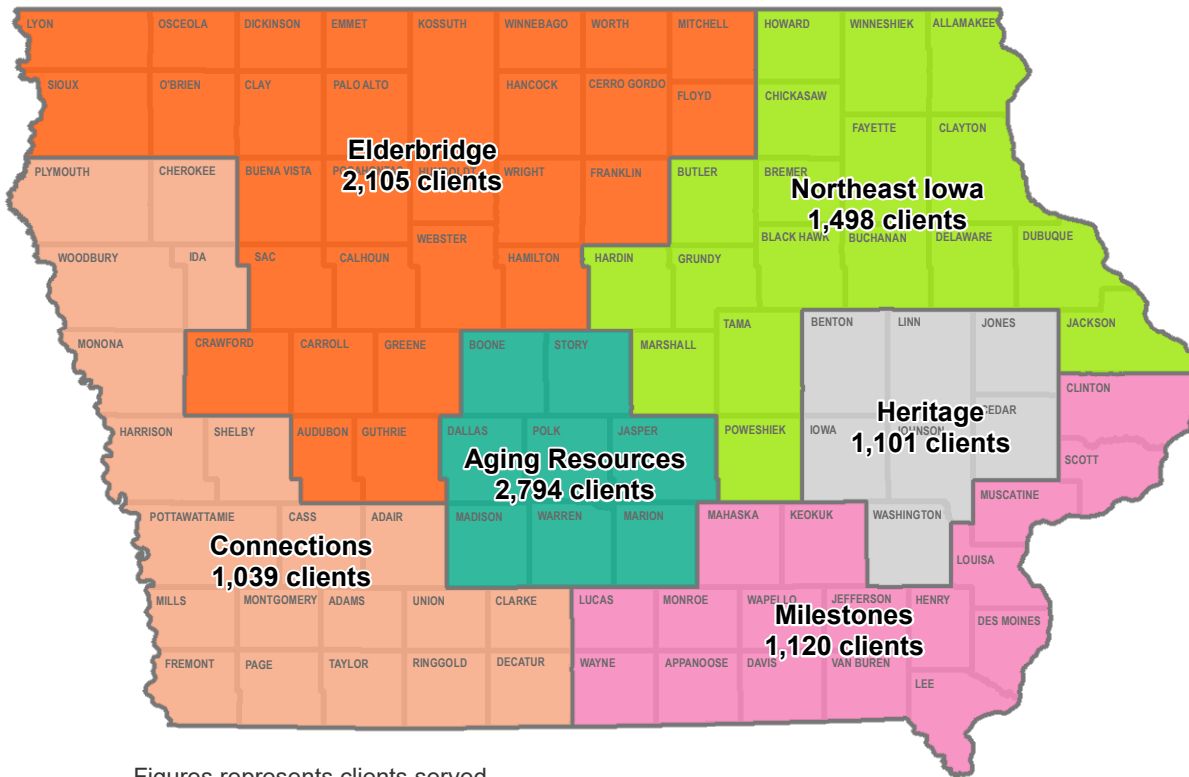


Area Agencies on Aging — FY 2025
