


Iowa Health and Wellness Plan Enrollment — 2025

The Iowa Health and Wellness Plan is a Medicaid program providing comprehensive health care coverage to low-income Iowans.

The Iowa Health and Wellness Plan covers adults ages 19 through 64 with income at or below 133 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). In 2025, the eligible income amount is \$20,831 for an individual or \$29,375 for a family of two. Members have the option of choosing a plan from one of three managed care organizations: Iowa Total Care, Molina Healthcare of Iowa, or Wellpoint Iowa (formerly Amerigroup Iowa, Inc.). Members also choose a dental plan provided by either Delta Dental of Iowa or MCNA Dental.
