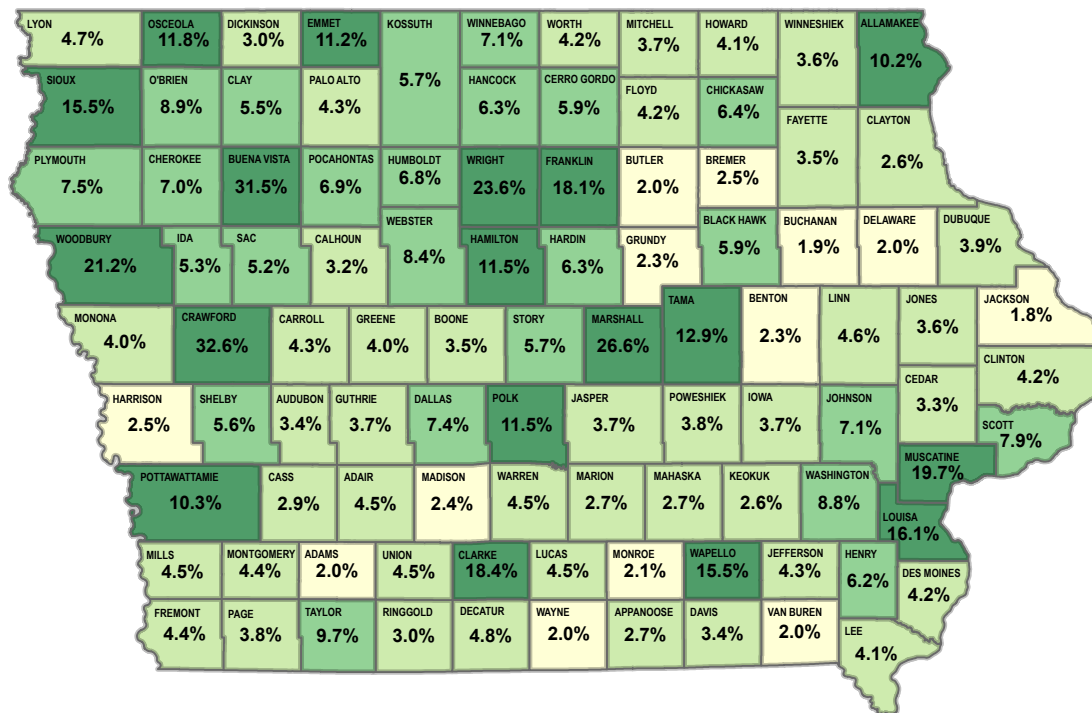


Hispanic or Latino (of Any Race) Population — 2025 Estimate

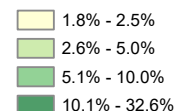

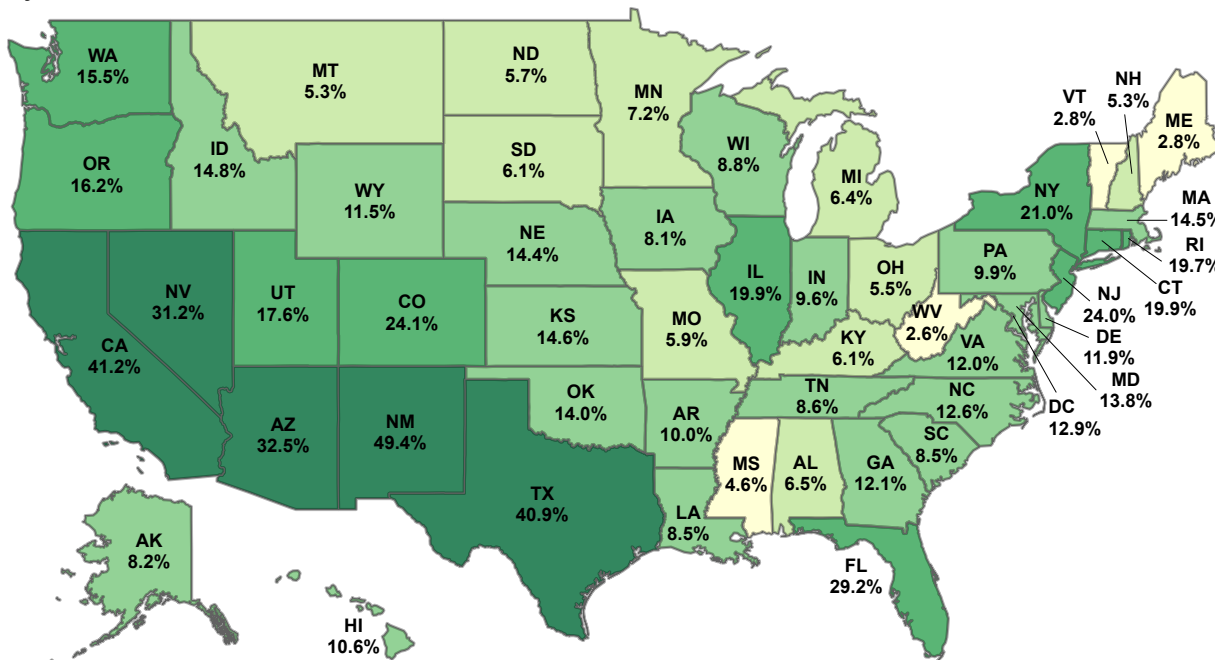

Percentage Hispanic or Latino



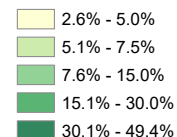
By State
