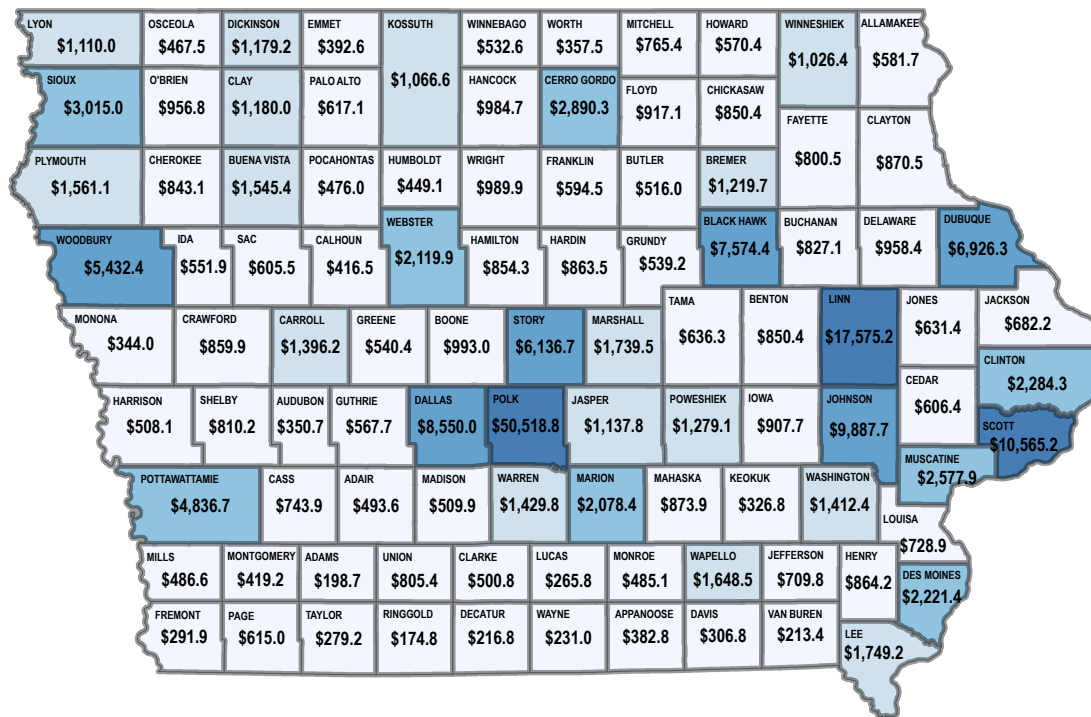


Iowa Gross Domestic Product (GDP) — Calendar Year 2024

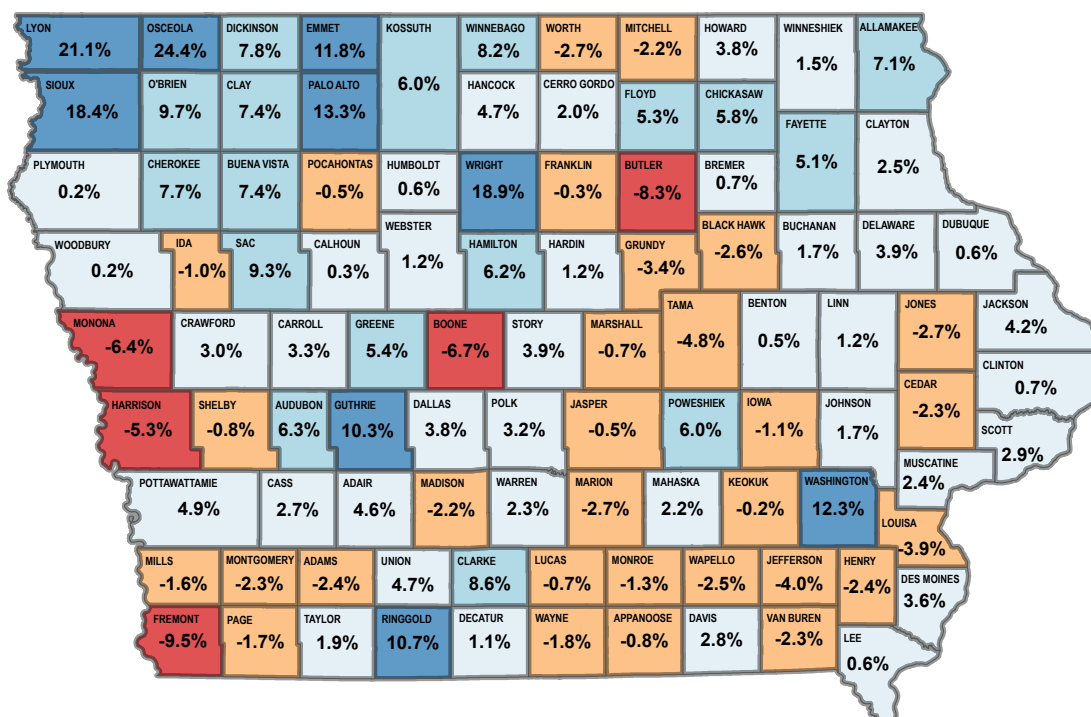

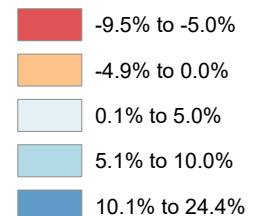
Percentage Change in GDP 2023 to 2024
