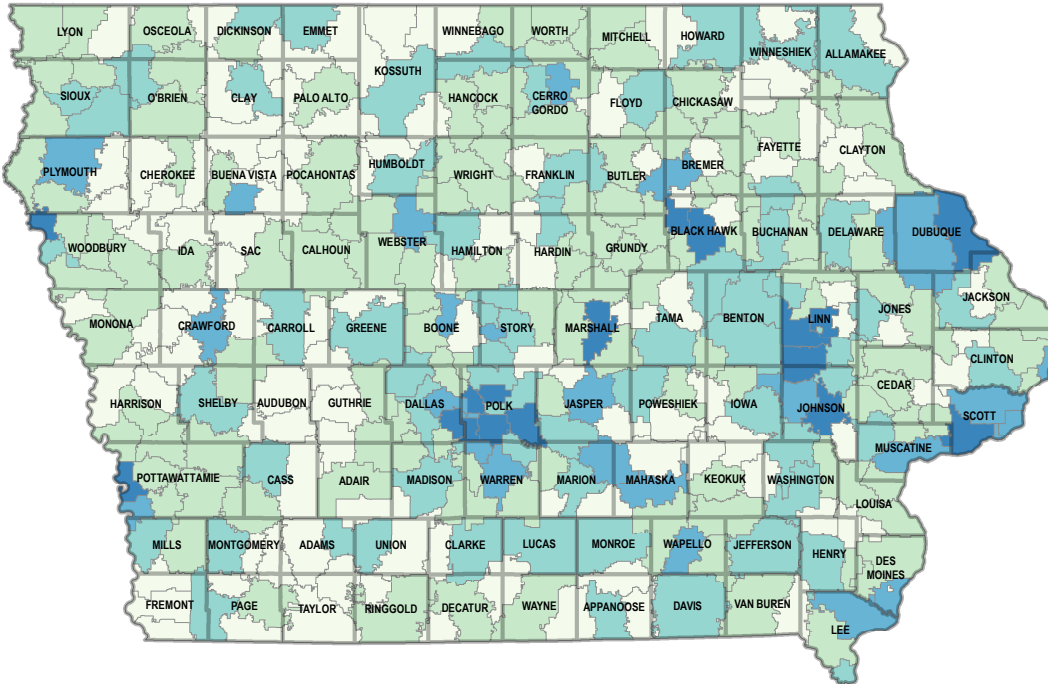


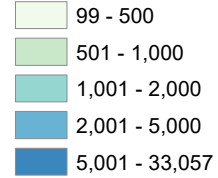

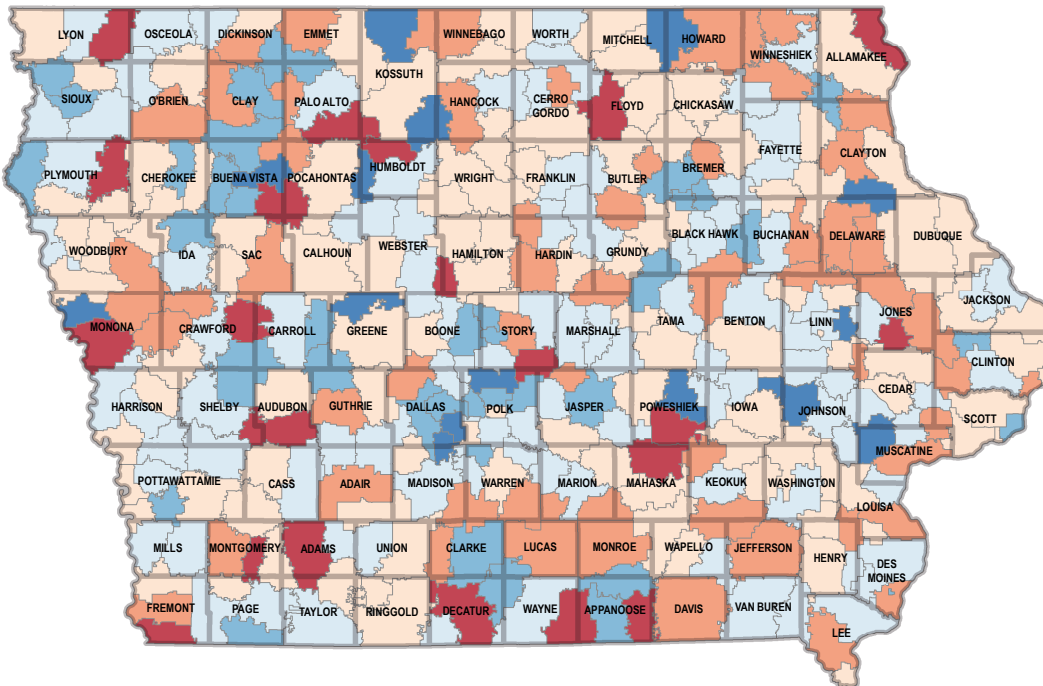

# Percent Change in Certified Enrollment — Fall 2017 vs. Fall 2016

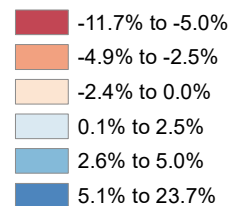
