Description

[Senate File 388](#) designates the portion of U.S. Highway 20 traversing the State of Iowa as the “Iowa Patriots Memorial Highway.” The Bill also allows for the Department of Transportation (DOT) to erect signs indicating the designation on or adjacent to the highway.

Background

U.S. Highway 20 extends 302 miles across Iowa through cities that include Dubuque and Sioux City. Currently, signage requirements are mandated by [761 IAC 131.10](#). Under the rule, applicants are responsible for the costs to install signs, including the posts and hardware.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact from [SF 388](#). However, if the DOT chose to erect signs, the cost to manufacture and install signs to designate the highway would be about \$300 per sign. If 40 signs were erected, the cost to the DOT would be approximately \$12,000 from the Primary Road Fund.
