## **Description**

**Senate File 227** as amended by House Amendment S-3184 allows a motor vehicle that is 25 years old or older, or built to resemble a vehicle 25 years old or older, to display a single registration plate on the rear of the vehicle. Under current law, a motor vehicle that is model year 1948 or older, or reconstructed to resemble a model year 1948 or older vehicle, is allowed to display a single registration plate on the rear of the vehicle.

The Bill as amended requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to conduct a study regarding the means available to identify a motor vehicle other than the display of a front registration plate.

## **Fiscal Impact**

**Senate File 227** as amended by the House will not have a measurable fiscal impact on the State, as current law will still require persons with vehicles 25 model years old or older to purchase two registration plates, but allow them to display only one.

The cost for the DOT and the DPS to conduct the study as required in the Bill cannot be determined at this time.
