### Description

[House File 2337](#) provides that a person who falsely represents oneself as possessing an academic degree or academic credentials for the purpose of obtaining employment or other personal gain is guilty of a fraudulent practice in the fifth degree. A fraudulent practice in the fifth degree is a simple misdemeanor.

### Fiscal Impact

The introduced version of House File 2337 required a **Fiscal Note**, which included estimated correctional, minority, and fiscal impacts. House File 2337 was amended on March 12, 2026, and the Bill no longer requires a **Fiscal Note**.
