## Description

Senate File 397 authorizes the Department of Natural Resources to issue an additional 18,000 antlerless deer hunting licenses to lowa residents for the 2003 through 2004 hunting seasons. The Bill allows licensed hunters to donate harvested deer to the Department of Corrections by delivering the deer to a designated meat processor.

## Assumptions

1. The Department of Natural Resources will sell between 8,000 and 9,000 antlerless deer licenses at $\$ 25.00$ during the 2003/2004 hunting season. Total revenues will range from $\$ 200,000$ to $\$ 225,000$.
2. The Department of Natural Resources will sell between 6,000 and 9,000 antlerless deer licenses at $\$ 10.00$ during the 2003/2004 hunting season. Total revenues will range from $\$ 60,000$ to $\$ 90,000$.
3. The Department of Corrections will purchase processed deer meat from designated meat processors if the delivered price is competitive with other purchased meat products, resulting in no fiscal impact.

## Correctional Impact

The correctional impact of SF 397 is expected to be minimal.

## Fiscal Impact

The estimated fiscal impact of SF 397 is an increase in revenue ranging between \$260,000 and \$315,000 to the Fish and Wildlife Trust fund for FY 2004.

The fiscal impact to the Department of Corrections is expected to be minimal.
