Description

House File 321 changes the bid threshold requirement for advertising for bids by various named governmental bodies for a contract for a public improvement from a cost of \$25,000 to a minimum cost of \$50,000. This change also applies to the threshold amount requirement to the bond requirement for construction of public improvements pursuant to Section 273.2, Code of lowa.

Assumptions

- House File 321 changes to various Sections of the <u>Code of Iowa</u> relate only to the amount of bid threshold requiring advertising for bids or bond requirement for construction of public improvements.
- 2. The Bill provides savings due to reduced people time, less advertising costs, and less required reporting.
- 3. The Bill may enable small capital improvement projects to be completed more timely, at less cost, and attract more small contractors.

Fiscal Impact

House File 321 will reduce costs associated with bidding requirements. The amount of total savings in State and local funds cannot be determined. The State Board of Regents estimates that the effects of this Bill will reduce its costs by \$215,000 for FY 2006 and FY 2007 based on an average of 66 construction bids per year for Regent institutions.
