Description

House File 675 requires Iowa State University to conduct a study regarding the economic, fiscal, and social impacts of establishing a “living wage,” also known as a “self-sufficiency wage,” in Iowa. The Bill requires various other State agencies and interested groups, as specified, to cooperate in the study and requires a report of the findings to be submitted to the General Assembly by December 14, 2007.

Fiscal Impact

Iowa State University estimates the cost for this study to be \$54,000 for salaries, support, and travel.
