Gambling Treatment Program — SWRF

Purpose and History

This appropriation from the <u>Sports Wagering Receipts Fund (SWRF)</u> is intended to supplement the <u>Iowa Gambling Treatment Program</u>, which also receives funding through the Addictive Disorders General Fund appropriation. Funding was first provided through 2019 Iowa Acts, chapter <u>133</u> (Gambling Treatment Program Appropriations Act).

Background

Legalized sports gambling and wagering began in Iowa in August 2019 through the implementation of 2019 Iowa Acts, chapter 132 (Sports Wagering and Fantasy Sports Contests Act).

Funding — Sports Wagering Receipts Fund

Revenue in the SWRF is derived from a 6.75% tax on the net receipts of sports wagering in Iowa. This funding is appropriated from the SWRF in the annual Health and Human Services Appropriation Act.
