# **Statewide Student Assessment**

### **Purpose and History**

The Statewide Student Assessment is used to assess students in grades three through eight and once in high school using an assessment that aligns to a state's math, reading, and science standards (in lowa, the lowa Core). The official assessment for the State of lowa is the University of lowa's <a href="Lowa Testing">Lowa Testing</a> <a href="Lowa Testing">Programs</a> (ITP). These assessments fulfill the requirements of the federal <a href="Lowa Testing">Every Student Succeeds Act</a>.

#### **Funding**

Previously, the cost of the statewide assessment was paid by school districts out of the districts' general funds. The General Assembly currently appropriates \$3.0 million annually to be distributed by the Department of Education to ITP on behalf of school districts to offset the cost of the Statewide Student Assessment. This appropriation includes an allocation of up to \$300,000 to ITP to offset the costs of administering the Statewide Student Assessment at accredited nonpublic schools.
