## **Budget Unit: Newsline for the Blind**

### **Program Overview**

Newsline for the Blind is a subscription service administered by the National Federation of the Blind (NFB) known as NFB-NEWSLINE®. NFB-NEWSLINE® provides, at no cost to blind and visually impaired individuals, daily access to newspapers and magazines over the phone toll-free. The Iowa Department for the Blind receives a General Fund appropriation to subscribe to the NFB-NEWSLINE® service.

Blind and visually impaired individuals have access over the telephone to the following:

- More than 320 daily newspapers including the Burlington Hawkeye, Cedar Rapids Gazette, Des Moines Register, Iowa City Press Citizen, Iowa Shopping Cart, Mason City Globe-Gazette, Quad City Times, Sioux City Journal, and Waterloo Courier.
- · Iowa Information Channel.
- Monthly Consumer bulletins from the Iowa Attorney General's Office.
- · Access to several magazines.
- Up to the minute feeds from the Associated Press.
- TV listings.
- · Ability to search for jobs.
- Ability to read weekly Target ads.
