University of Iowa — Cancer Research

Purpose and History

The 2025 Iowa Acts, [Senate File 647](#) (FY 2026 Education Appropriations Act), created the University of Iowa (SUI) — Cancer Research Program appropriation to the University of Iowa under the Iowa Board of Regents. The program will fund the Iowa Cancer Assessment and Intervention Plan under the direction of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). The Plan will include a thorough analysis of potential causes of Iowa's high incidence of cancer to guide HHS in developing targeted policies, enhancing prevention and screening programs, raising public awareness, and integrating evidence-based findings into existing initiatives.

Funding — State General Fund

The SUI — Cancer Research Program is funded through a General Fund appropriation made in the Education Appropriations Subcommittee. In 2025 Iowa Acts, Senate File 647, an appropriation of \$1.0 million was made to the Department of Education for this purpose.
