### Foreign Animal Disease General — IADPF

#### Purpose and History

The Foreign Animal Disease Preparedness and Response Strategy was established in 2017 Iowa Acts, chapter [168](#) (FY 2018 Agriculture and Natural Resources Appropriations Act). The goal of the Strategy is to develop a practical and cost-effective plan that will be implemented to control and/or eradicate foreign animal diseases. The appropriation from the Iowa Animal Disease Prevention Fund (IADPF) will assist the Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (DALs) in achieving the goals of the Strategy.

In FY 2025, SF [646](#) (FY 2026 Agriculture and Natural Resources Appropriations Act) eliminated the Brucellosis and Tuberculosis Eradication Fund and replaced it with the Iowa Animal Disease Preparedness Fund (IADPF).

#### Funding — IADPF

This is a new appropriation of \$100,000 in FY 2026 from the IADPF to the Foreign Animal Disease Preparedness and Response Fund, and is in addition to a General Fund appropriation of \$1.1 million.
