Field Facility Deferred Maintenance (DOT)

Purpose and History

Activities funded with this appropriation include renovation and replacement of aging facilities operated by the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT). The DOT maintains 1,174 buildings totaling more than 4.1 million square feet. The DOT defers maintenance on these facilities as long as possible and anticipates continued demand to replace and renovate facilities.

The DOT develops three-year plans for repairs and major improvements to its buildings. Projects are identified by individual districts and reported centrally to Support Services. Support Services then determines what should be replaced or repaired, determines the priority of requested projects, and sets repair schedules based upon available funding.

State Funding

The DOT receives an appropriation from the Primary Road Fund (PRF) for deferred maintenance projects at various statewide field facilities. Since FY 2015, the appropriation has been static at \$1.7 million.
