Dear Chief Clerk Boal:

Kevin McCarthy's responsibilities in my office involve, among other things, fighting elder fraud. Because the legislature is being particularly active this year in this area, Kevin has been increasingly called over to the legislature to answer questions and to provide support to agency staff. Therefore, it makes sense at this time to have Kevin register to represent the official position of the Iowa Attorney General's Office so that he may advocate for or against legislation related to elder fraud for the remainder of the 2014 General Assembly.

This letter is pursuant to House Rule 20 which allows for a more limited scope of advocacy and serves as my authorization to allow Kevin McCarthy to advocate for or against any elder fraud or abuse legislation. This authorization includes related issues that were contained in the legislatively mandated 2013 Elder Abuse / Fraud Task Force recommendations submitted by the Department on Aging, such as power of attorney legislation and substitute decision maker or guardianship issues, including budget issues related to these areas.
