1 Amend House File 2161 as follows:

2 1. By striking everything after the enacting clause and  
3 inserting:

4 <Section 1. Section 321P.4, Code 2026, is amended by adding  
5 the following new subsections:

6 NEW SUBSECTION. 01. A person shall not use an automatic  
7 registration plate reader in a local authority unless  
8 the governing body of the local authority has adopted an  
9 ordinance authorizing the use of a plate reader in the local  
10 authority. The ordinance must provide the name or employment  
11 classification of persons authorized to access a plate reader.

12 NEW SUBSECTION. 001. *a.* A person shall not access an  
13 automatic registration plate reader to perform a search unless  
14 the search is related to a call for service or case and the  
15 call for service or case is identified by an assigned specific  
16 number. However, if exigent circumstances exist and a specific  
17 number has not been assigned, a person may search a plate  
18 reader without providing a call for service number or case  
19 number at the time of the search, and the person shall add the  
20 call for service number or case number, as applicable, after  
21 the number is assigned.

22 *b.* A person who accesses a plate reader shall record the  
23 person's access in a records log maintained by the local  
24 authority or in the plate reader's vendor-generated audit  
25 logs. The log must include the call for service number or case  
26 number, as applicable, and the reason for accessing the plate  
27 reader.

28 NEW SUBSECTION. 0001. *a.* A person shall not add a  
29 registration plate to a database if the database includes  
30 specific registration plates for which an automatic  
31 registration plate reader is designed to provide an alert  
32 when the plate reader identifies a registration plate from  
33 the database, unless the person provides the call for service  
34 number or case number in the database entry.

35 *b.* A person shall not rely on an alert from a plate reader

1 unless the person independently verifies the validity of the  
2 alert other than by using a plate reader.

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. A person shall not provide a copy  
4 of an image of a vehicle registration plate, or any other  
5 accompanying data, captured by an automatic registration plate  
6 reader to a third party unless the third party is one of the  
7 following:

8 a. A peace officer or law enforcement agency.

9 b. A person who has a contract with a law enforcement agency  
10 for the sole purpose of protecting public safety, conducting  
11 criminal investigations, or ensuring compliance with federal,  
12 state, or local law.

13 c. The national insurance crime bureau or its successor  
14 organization, an insurance carrier, or an insurance support  
15 organization, solely for the purpose of investigating insurance  
16 fraud, assisting in vehicle recovery, or adjudicating insurance  
17 claims.

18 NEW SUBSECTION. 2B. A person shall not use an automatic  
19 registration plate reader that is able to recognize or identify  
20 a person based on a photograph or recording of the person's  
21 face captured by the plate reader. A person who uses a plate  
22 reader shall not use software designed to recognize or identify  
23 a person based on a photograph or recording of the person's  
24 face captured by the plate reader.

25 NEW SUBSECTION. 2C. A person shall not place an automatic  
26 registration plate reader directed at a church, synagogue, or  
27 other established place of religious worship, unless the person  
28 has consent from the affected church, synagogue, or other  
29 established place of religious worship, as applicable.

30 NEW SUBSECTION. 2D. The governing body of a local authority  
31 that authorized the use of an automatic registration plate  
32 reader shall audit or cause an audit of the use of each plate  
33 reader within the local authority at least once every three  
34 months. The governing body of the local authority shall  
35 document the audit.

1     Sec. 2. Section 321P.4, subsection 4, Code 2026, is amended  
2 to read as follows:

3     4. a. A person who willfully and intentionally violates  
4 subsection 01, 001, 0001, 1, or 2C commits a simple  
5 misdemeanor.

6     b. A person who violates subsection 2A or 2B for personal  
7 gain or while violating any other provision of law commits  
8 unauthorized computer access in violation of section 716.6B,  
9 subsection 1, paragraph "a".

10    Sec. 3. Section 716.6B, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code  
11 2026, is amended to read as follows:

12    a. An aggravated misdemeanor if computer data is accessed  
13 that contains a confidential record, as defined in section  
14 22.7, an image of a vehicle registration plate or any other  
15 accompanying data captured by an automatic registration plate  
16 reader in violation of section 321P.4, subsection 2A or 2B,  
17 operational or support data of a public utility, as defined  
18 in section 476.1, operational or support data of a rural  
19 water district incorporated pursuant to chapter 357A or 504,  
20 operational or support data of a municipal utility organized  
21 pursuant to chapter 388 or 389, operational or support data  
22 of a public airport, or a trade secret, as defined in section  
23 550.2.>

7 except that if the winner is not present, notification to the  
8 winner shall be made ~~as soon as practical~~ within one year of  
9 the prize being awarded.>

6 hundredths> and inserting <five>

7 3. Page 5, by striking lines 2 through 15 and inserting:

8 <STATE COST PER PUPIL

9 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 257.9, subsection 2, paragraph i, Code  
10 2026, is amended to read as follows:

11 *i.* For the budget year beginning July 1, 2026, ~~and~~  
12 ~~succeeding budget years~~, the regular program state cost per  
13 pupil ~~for a budget year~~ is the regular program state cost per  
14 pupil for the base year plus the regular program supplemental  
15 state aid for the budget year, plus five dollars.

16 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 257.9, subsection 2, Code 2026, is amended  
17 by adding the following new paragraph:

18 NEW PARAGRAPH. *j.* For the budget year beginning July 1,  
19 2027, and succeeding budget years, the regular program state  
20 cost per pupil for a budget year is the regular program state  
21 cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program  
22 supplemental state aid for the budget year.

23 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. EFFECTIVE DATE. This division of this Act, being  
24 deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.>

25 4. By striking page 5, line 33, through page 6, line 30, and  
26 inserting:

27 <Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. EDUCATION SUPPORT PERSONNEL SALARY SUPPLEMENT —  
28 FY 2026-2027.

29 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state  
30 to the department of education for the fiscal year beginning  
31 July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, the following amount,  
32 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes  
33 designated:

34 To supplement education support personnel compensation:  
35 ..... \$ 14,000,000

1 2. Moneys appropriated in this section are miscellaneous  
2 income as defined in section 257.2 and shall not be included  
3 in any computation of district cost under chapter 257 for any  
4 budget year.

5 3. Moneys appropriated in this section shall be used to  
6 provide a funding supplement to each school district during the  
7 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, to supplement education  
8 support personnel compensation.

9 4. In order to receive the funding supplement, a school  
10 district shall first report to the department of education  
11 on or before July 1, 2026, the number of education support  
12 personnel employed by the school district, including all  
13 other information related to such personnel required by the  
14 department of education. Each school district's funding  
15 supplement amount shall be equal to \$14,000,000 multiplied by  
16 the quotient of the school district's budget enrollment for the  
17 budget year beginning July 1, 2025, divided by the statewide  
18 total budget enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1,  
19 2025.

20 5. For purposes of this section, "education support  
21 personnel" means regular and part-time employees of a school  
22 district who are not salaried.

23 6. The payment of funding supplement amounts under this  
24 section shall be paid by the department of education at the  
25 same time and in the same manner as foundation aid is paid  
26 under section 257.16 for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
27 2026, and may be included in the monthly payment of state aid  
28 under section 257.16, subsection 2.

30 SCHOOL DISTRICT ENROLLMENT

31 Sec. \_\_\_\_ . Section 257.6, subsection 2, Code 2026, is amended  
32 to read as follows:

33 2. *Basic enrollment.* Basic enrollment for a budget year  
34 is the greater of a district's actual enrollment for the base  
35 year and the district's adjusted enrollment for the base

1 year. Basic enrollment for the base year is the greater of  
2 a district's actual enrollment for the year preceding the  
3 base year and the district's adjusted enrollment for the year  
4 preceding the base year.

5 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. Section 257.6, Code 2026, is amended by adding the  
6 following new subsection:

7 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Adjusted enrollment.

8 a. Adjusted enrollment is determined annually on January  
9 15, or the third Monday in January if January 15 falls on  
10 a Saturday or Sunday, and includes the same categories of  
11 pupils used to determine actual enrollment under subsection 1,  
12 paragraph "a".

13 b. A school district shall certify its adjusted enrollment  
14 to the department of education by February 15 of each year, and  
15 the department shall promptly forward the information to the  
16 department of management.

17 c. The department of management shall adjust the basic  
18 enrollment of the school district for the audit year based upon  
19 reports filed under section 11.6, and shall further adjust the  
20 budget of the second year succeeding the audit year for the  
21 property tax and state aid portions of the reported differences  
22 in such enrollments for the year succeeding the audit year.

23 Sec. \_\_\_\_\_. APPLICABILITY. This division of this Act applies  
24 to enrollment determinations occurring on or after July 1,  
25 2026, used for school budget years beginning on or after July  
26 1, 2027.>

27 5. Page 6, by striking lines 31 through 35 and inserting:

29 <providing education support personnel funding, making  
30 appropriations,>>
