Adrian B. Brinck, 89, of West Point, died Thursday, July 3, 2003, at the West Point Care Center.

He was born Oct. 31, 1913, to Bernard and Loretta Link Brinck in West Point. He was a lifelong resident of the West Point area.



On Feb. 5, 1944, Mr. Brinck married Arlowine L. Arie in Fort Madison. She survives.

He was preceded in death by: his parents, brother. Vern; two sisters, Gloria Brinck and Virginia Paschal.

Mr. Brinck's body has been cremated.
