Adrian Brinck

Adrian B. Brinck, 89, of West Point, died Thursday, July 3, 2003, at the West Point Care Center.

He was born Oct. 31, 1913, to Bernard and Loretta Link Brinck in West Point. He was a lifelong resident of the West Point area.

On Feb. 5, 1944, Mr. Brinck married Arlowine L. Arie in Fort Madison. She survives.

He worked with his father in the outdoor advertising and theater business. He enlisted in the Marines in January, 1942, and served in World War II from October 1942, through January 1944. He was discharged in 1945 as a staff sergeant.

Mr. Brinck was active in politics and served on the West Point City Council, served two terms as mayor, four terms as an Iowa state representative and one term as a Lee County Supervisor. He also served on the West Point Public School Board, Marquette School Board, the West Point Volunteer Fire Department, as Commander of the American Legion Post



No. 668 and as a state legislative director for the AARP.

Besides his wife, he is survived by four sons: Michael Brinck (wife Marla) of Annapolis, Md.; Steve Brinck (wife Laura) of West Point; John Brinck of West Point; Jim Brinck (wife Rhonda) of Fort Madison; three daughters: Mary Jo Metzler (husband Joe) of Alexandria, Va.; Sallie Kloewer (husband Jim) of Keosauqua; Barbara Shafer (husband Robert) of Dubuque; 15 grandchildren and one sister, Ruth Ryan of Olean, New York.

He was preceded in death by: his parents, brother, Vern; two sisters, Gloria Brinck and Virginia Paschal.

Mr. Brinck's body has been cremated.

Visitation will begin after 2:30 p.m. Monday, July 7, at Link Funeral Home in West Point. A rosary will be recited at 3 p.m. A Christian Vigil Service will be recited at 7 p.m. and family will meet friends from 6 to 8 p.m.

A memorial service will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday, July 8, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, West Point. Father Apo T. Mpanda will officiate. Burial will be in Calvary Cemetery with full military rites at the grave.
