He served on the house judiciary, Iowa development, appropriations and environmental control committees. He also was a member of the important budget and financial control committee.

He was owner and operator of the Illini Molded Plastics Co., in Lisbon, and had been active in Cedar Rapids chapter of the American Society of Tool and Manufacturing Engineers, YMCA Toastmasters club in Cedar Rapids, Waubeek Council of Boy Scouts of America and the Cedar Rapids Symphony Orchestra.

Surviving besides his wife are four sons, a daughter and eight grandchildren.

His body has been willed to the University of Iowa medical school as a contribution to the living. There will be no funeral services. The family suggests that friends may, if they wish, contribute to the Cancer Society or the Lisbon-library memorial fund.
